The Federal government recently released the final rule for implementing the HIPAA 5010 electronic transaction standard for health care claims. It calls for all health care trading partners to be ready to exchange 5010 transactions starting December 2010. Starting January 1, 2012, all transactions must be exchanged using the 5010 standard. The new 5010 standard will be the basis for health care administrative transactions, including claims, remittance, eligibility, and claims status requests and responses.
